

**LEAP** is an international nonprofit educational organization created to give voice to current and former members of law enforcement, who believe the war on drugs has failed and support alternative policies of drug regulation and control that will save lives, reduce disease, lower addiction rates, lessen crime, and conserve tax dollars, by ending drug prohibition.

#### **THE MISSION OF LEAP IS:**

(1) To educate the public, the media, and policy makers, to the failure of current drug policy by presenting a true picture of the history, causes and effects of drug abuse and the crimes related to drug prohibition; (2) To create a speakers bureau staffed with knowledgeable and articulate former drug-warriors who describe the impact of current drug policies on: police/community relations; the safety of law enforcement officers and suspects; police corruption and misconduct; and the financial and human costs associated with current drug policies; (3) To restore the public's respect for law enforcement that has been diminished by its involvement in imposing drug prohibition; (4) To reduce the multitude of harms resulting from fighting the war on drugs and to lessen the incidence of death, disease, crime, and addiction by ultimately ending drug prohibition

#### **WHAT CAN LEAP DO FOR YOU?**
